attaine the Age of one and twenty years I will that the same shall be assigned
to him for all the Remouder which shall be due to some of my Deere here in but
if he shall dye before that Age I will that the Rents and proffits thereof shall
be used and employed for the maintenance and good education of my said
Daughter until she shall attaine her Age of eightene years And when she
shall attaine to that Age I will that the same shall be assigned to her for all the
Remouder which shall be due to some of my Deere here in And if she shall at
all dye I give the Remouder which shall be due to some of my Deere here in
to the Daughter and Daughters of my eldest Sonne Henry Gleson equally & in
betwene them Item all the rest and residue of my personall Estate chattells real
and personall household stuff monyes rights and reditts I will shall be received
and converted into monyes by my said Executors and shall be by them and in
their names but to and for the uses intents and purposes in and by this my last
Will and Testament limited expressed and declared putt forth to Interest
that the Interest and increase thereof shall be added to the principall stock
for the augmentation thereof But if neede shall require I will that the said
Interest and increase or for want thereof as shall suffice hereunto shall be
used and employed for or towards the maintenance and good education of my
said Sonne and Daughter Walter and Anne and for putting my said Sonne
Walter Apprentice to some good trade or to place and maintain him at the
University of Oxford if he shall desire the same And when my said Sonne
Walter shall attaine the Age of one and twenty years I will that two thirds
of the said principall stock and of the Augmentation thereof shall be paid to him
for his own use and benefitt and that one third part of the said principall stock and
of the Augmentation thereof shall be paid to my said Daughter Anne at her
said Age of eightene years for her own use and benefitt and her retent for
the same shall be a sufficient discharge to my said Executors And if my said

give and devise all those my four closes or parcells of ground called Sparks meade
situate in Insoldon at Brislington aforesaid immediately after the
Marriage or death of my said Wife which shall first happen to my said
Sonne Walter and the issues of his body lawfully begotten and for want
of issue I give and devise the same to my said Daughter Anne and

 the holding of our Thomas Jones) immediately after the Marriage or death of
 my said Wife whiche shall first happen to my said Daughter Anne and
 the share of her body lawfully begotten and for want of such share I give
 and devise the same to my said Sonne Walter and the share of his body
 lawfully begotten and for want of such share I give and devise the same to the
 Daughter and Daughters of my said Sonne Henry her and their share assigne
 for ever in joynt tenancy Item I will that the Rents and profits of the premises
 above devised to my said Sonne and Daughter Walter and Anne respectively
 shall be received and taken by my Executors untill my said Sonne Walter
 shall attaine his age of fifteen years and untill my said Daughter shall
 attaine her said age of sixteen years and that the same shall be from time
 to time putt forth to interest by my Executors in such manner as is above directed
 for the respective uses of my said Sonne and Daughter Walter and Anne and
 paid to them respectively when they shall attaine their respective ages above
 mentioned or if need shall require to be used and employed for them respective
 maintenance and good duracion as above specified And I will that my said
 Executors or any of them shall not be charged or chargeable with any casual loss
 of my Estate or of the Rents and profits of the premises above devised or of the
 money whiche shall be by them putt forth to interest as above directed desiring my
 said Executors and every of them to use their best care for the preservation
 thereof And in the performance of this my Will and their reasonable Costs
 charges and expences whiche they or any of them shall pay or be at therein or do
 therein about I will that they and every of them shall deduct and retayne to him
 themselves out of my Estate hereby given and devised And lastly I doe revoke
 and make void all other Wills and Testaments by me formerly made and
 declared these presents contained in these eight sheets of paper written on one
 side only to be my only last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have
 to each of the said sheets sett my hand and scale this eight day of September
 in the five and thirtieth year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lord Charles
 the second by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King
 Defender of the Faith &c. Anno Domini M^o C^o LXX^o III^o Idibus
 Septembris Anno Regni nostri septimo et publicis by the said Henry Clerk
 to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of Thomas Meredith William
