marthant benige thanke be to god in god and perfect remembrance haue  
made this my last will and Testament as followeth firste I commit  
and bequith my soule and bodie in to the hands of Almighty Godsted  
and bequith my soule and bodie in to the hands of Almighty Godsted  
fastlie beleuynge with a lueby faithe to be saued throught the merit of  
onlie Sauiour and Redeemer Iesus Christe Item I quie and bequith vnto  
my brother Israell Gleson in token of forgettynge and forgyngge all vnto  
to me by him receiued one Goblet of silver parrell gilt. Item I quie vnto my  
most welbeloued and naturall sister Marie Ellis one ale ruppe of silver  
parrell gilt. Item I quie vnto my saide sister Marie my downe bedde with  
his bolster with vnto her owne horse and also my quarter parte of the horse  
holde stuffe at Bathford. Item I quie vnto my rosen Phillippe Ellis my  
sheetes. Item I quie vnto my rosen Marie Ellis one paire of silke  
sheetes. Item I quie vnto my rosen Emmanuell Ashe all my apperrell and  
three poundes in money. I quie vnto my moste faithfull and welbeloued  
brother William Gleson my parte of the garden and ourbyarde in horstgate  
with the houses stable and all whatsoeuer thereto belongeth with the  
euidences and writtinges thereto appertaininge Also I quie and bequith  
thereto belongeth with a boorde peere of ground bynne in halliards  
Lane whollie and fullie as it is specified in a tomeyance made to me of yr  
by my father with all the euidences thereto likewise belongeth more I  
quie vnto the saide William all my righte title and interst in Bathford  
the houses stuffe onlie excepted more I quie vnto the saide William  
three poundes in money for the wherby my brother in lawe m<sup>r</sup> William  
Ellis is bounde vnto me in a boorde of one hundred markes to paie it me or  
my assignes one yere after my fathers decease wherby bond my father  
hath in his keepinge Likewise I quie vnto him all my right title and  
Interest in Disburie with the Euidences thereto belongeth Item I

quic vnto Robert Browne a lme fman and his wife one free se gonme a peere and five shils  
 Inged in mome a peere to buy them hose and shoes All the rest of my goodes not giuen  
 nor bequeathed I quic vnto my saide wellbeloued brother william Gleson whome  
 I doe make constitute and ordaine to be my full and whole Executor of this my last will  
 and Testament I prouided alwaies that my wellbeloued father walter Gleson shall enioy  
 and possesse all the afore saide goodes howsoever stuffe plate with the howses and things  
 or thare and garden, or any thing els what soeuer a bouche perteyneth in this my saide last  
 will and Testament duringe his naturall life and after his decesse to be distributed  
 and deliuered by my saide Executor as it is aboue mentioned In witness whereof I haue  
 written this with mine owne hand and haue here vnto put my hand and scale yeeve  
 the daie and yeare aboue written Subscribed sealed acknowledged and deliuered by  
 me Thomas Gleson to be his last will and Testament the eight daie of October  
 One thousand five hundred and twenety two in the presence of vs vnderwritten Jo:

 my wife thre score ewes of my best sheepe that I haue at my howse of ffardell  
 all my Swine pigge greate and smale I quic vnto Dorothy Valsighe my wife be
