 case he happen to dye before me I give and bequeath the same two hundred pounds to sure
 of his children as shall be living at the time of his death to be equally divided amongst
 them Item I give and bequeath to every of my Grandchildren that shall be living at the
 time of my decease the sume of Twenty pounds Item I give and bequeath to the said
St William Wynne the sume of Twenty pounds to buy him a Ring and to my Lady
Wenelope Wynne his wife the sume of Twenty pounds to buy her a Ring Item I give
 and bequeath to **Elizabeth David** who hath lived with mee a long time the sume
 of Twenty pounds Item I give and bequeath to my son in Law **Griffith Godurda**
 the sume of ffty hundred pounds All the rest and residue my Estate real and
 personall in Law and Equity I give devise and bequeath to my dear and loving
 husband **Griffith Godurda** whom I doe hereby make constitute and ordaine sole
 Executor of this my last will and Testament Provided allwaied that if any the
 debts due to mee should prove desperate so that my personall Estate should not
 extend to satisfy all the said Legacies then my will and meaning is that so
 much the less shall goe to my said son in Law **Griffith Godurda** In witness
 whereof I have to this my last will and Testament subscribed in two sheets of paper
 that is to say to each sheet thereof set my Marke under my owne hand and seale
 this **Six** and **Twenty** day of **November** in the **Three** and **Twenty** year of the
 Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord **Charles** the **second** by the grace of God King of England

 and Testament in manner and forme following that is to say first whereas **John**
aforsaid **God** doe stand possid of or interred in the Capital messuage in the Parish
 of **St. Bridget** alias **Widdes** aforsaid wherein I doe now dwell and the two messuages
 thereunto adjoining and situate on the East side of my said Capital messuage and of
 and in these houses in one of the new streets betweene **Thoc Lane** and **fflter Lane** in the
 Parish of **St. Bridget** alias **Widdes** by mee heretofore devised to **Alan Hadley** ffounder
 and by **humbull** And the Costs and Grounds wherein the same houses doe stand with
 theire and every of theire appurtenances And of all my houses Lands and Tenements in
 that Parish by vertue and meane of a certaine Indenture bearing date the ffve

 Reigne of our Sovereign Lord King Charles the second and made or intended to be made
 betwene mee the said Francis Ellison of the one part and them the said John Horne
 and William Warstone of the other part by which I have assigned or intended to assigne
 the same house and premises and the severall Leases thereof to wit two Leases here-
 tofore made to William Warstone by the Wardens and Commonalty of the Mystery of
 the Goldsmiths of the City of London and by him assigned unto mee two other Leases
 thereof made by the said Wardens and Commonalty to mee the said Francis Ellison and one
 Lease made to mee by James Goddard unto them the said John Horne and William Warstone
 their executors administrators and assigned to have and to hold to them their
 executors administrators and assigned upon the speciall trust and confidence and to
 the intent and purpose that they the said John Horne and William Warstone and the
 survivors of them and the executors administrators and assigned of the survivors of them
 should assigne surrender or assigne and dispose of the said Leases and premises in such
 manner and to such persons and for such intents and purposes as I the said Francis Ellison
 by my last will and Testament in writing or by any writing under my hand and seal
 testified by two or more credible witnesses should direct or appoint do by the said
 recited Indenture may more at large appeare Now I the said Francis Ellison by
 vertue of and according to the trusts and powers aforesaid and by vertue of all other
 powers waied and meant enabling mee therunto doe appoint and direct that my Nephew
 and Francis Ellison one of the sons of my brother M^r John Ellison shall have receave
 take and be paid out of all the same Messuaged Lands and Tenements with the appurtenances
 in the Parish of St Andrew which he had aforesaid and the Rents issues and profits
 thereof yearly and every year for and during all the term and time deemed and times
 of the said Leases or any of them if by the said Francis Ellison shall be long live the years
 sume or payment of twenty thousand of lawfull money of England at the feasts of the
 birth of our Lord God the Annunciation of the blessed virgin Mary St John the Baptist
 and St Michael the Archangell by even and equall portions the first payment thereof
 to be made at the end of Six monthes after the first or next day that shall happen
 after my decease Item I doe give and bequeath unto my Niece M^{rs} Jane Dowell wife
 of M^r Richard Dowell the sume of Ten thousand Item I doe give and bequeath unto my
 brother Doctor Henry Ellison the sume of ffifty thousand and the sume of Ten thousand
 to buy him Mourning Item I doe give unto my said brother's wife ffortye shillings to buy
 her a Ring and to each of his two daughters ffortye shillings to buy each of them a Ring
 And I doe give unto each of my said brother's said two daughters by bands ffortye
 shillings to buy them Rings Item I doe give and bequeath unto my brother M^r John
 Ellison Ten thousand to buy him Mourning Item I doe give and bequeath to Jane Mary
 and hester daughter of my said brother M^r John Ellison one hundred thousand a peece
 to be paid by my Executor herein after named at their respective dayes of Marriage
 or at the end of three yeares next after my decease which severall of them shall first
 happen And if any or either of them dye unmarried before the end of three yeares
 after my decease then I will that her or their Leases, so dying shall remaine to the
 survivor or survivor of them Item I doe give and bequeath unto my Nephew M^r William
 Ellison the sume of Ten thousand to buy him Mourning And I doe give and bequeath unto
 my Nephew M^r Gilbert Ellison the sume of ffive thousand And I doe give doo and
 bequeath unto my Nephew M^r George Brown all my house Lands and Tenements
 situate and being in Abchurch Lane neere Grayes Church Lane or elsewhere in the Parish
 of St Andrew Holborne in the County of Mith And all and every my Leases and
 Counterserts of Leases and the Rents and profits thereof And all the estate Right
 Title Interest terme and termes of yeares property claim and Demand that I
 may or ought to have in and to the same and every or any of them And to hold
 to him the said George Brown his executors administrators and assigned for ever

In the terms limited and Estate as I have may should or ought to have therein And
 I do give and bequeath unto my neere M^{rs} Mary Younger the sume of Ten poundes And
 to her husband M^r John Younger husband of my neere Mary Younger the sume of Ten poundes And
 the sume of Eighty poundes by specialty my will and mind is that the same Eighty poundes be
 paid unto and among the children of the said Mary Younger part and part like and be divided
 and shared amongst them by even and equal portions And whereas M^r James Maydwell is
 and standeth indebted to me the sume of one hundred and thirty poundes upon two severall
 bondes one for thirty poundes and the other for one hundred poundes my will and mind is
 that the said thirty poundes be paid unto and shared and divided amongst the children of
 the said James Maydwell and Elizabeth his wife by even and equal portions I do
 give unto my sister M^{rs} Mary Holm if she be living at the time of my death the sume of
 Ten poundes to buy her a peece of plate And I do give unto my nephew John
 Holm Elamre the sume of Ten poundes to buy him a peece of plate And I do give
 unto my nephew M^r James Holm the sume of Ten poundes to buy him a peece of plate
 And I do give unto my neere M^{rs} Mary Younger the sume of five poundes to buy her a peece
 of plate And I give unto M^{rs} Ann Hillary the sume of five poundes And I give and
 bequeath unto my neere M^{rs} Mary Sam the sume of thirty poundes And I do give and
 bequeath unto M^{rs} Sarah Warfield widow the sume of one hundred poundes and all
 the sume of five poundes to buy her mourning And I do give and bequeath unto Mary
 Warfield daughter of the said M^{rs} Sarah Warfield the sume of Ten poundes And I
 do give and bequeath unto Gaud Colledge in the universitie of Cambridge (of which he
 was formerly a fellow) two peeces of plate each of them of the value of six
 poundes thirtene shillings and flower went with the sume of the said Colledge and
 my Armes and ad of my Coft engraven thereupon And I do give unto Trinity hall in
 Cambridge aforesaid a peece of plate of the value of six poundes thirtene shillings
 and flower went with the sume of the said hall and my Armes and ad of my
 Coft engraven thereupon I do give unto M^r George Ent knight a peece of plate
 of the value of five poundes And I do give unto M^r Charles Scarborough a peece of
 plate of the value of five poundes And I do give unto Doctor Goddard a peece of plate
 of the value of five poundes And I do give unto Doctor Stained a peece of plate of
 the value of five poundes And I do give unto Doctor Carr one of the fellows of
 Christ Colledge in Cambridge a peece of plate of the value of five poundes And I do
 give and bequeath unto the universitie of Cambridge

Maydwell doth owe mee one hundred poundes by Bond as aforesaid (which I have not heretofore disposed of.) And whereas my said Brother Francis Shenton Esq^r doth owe mee fiftie poundes by Bond as by the said severall Wills and the severall Conditions therof may respectively appear. My Will and mind is And I doe hereby give devise and bequeath the same severall sumes of one hundred and fiftie poundes unto my said Nephew Mr William Ellison and to my Nephew Mr George Brown upon trust and Confidence and to the intent and purpose that the same sumes of one hundred and fiftie poundes may be laid out and disposed of for the use and benefit of Mary the wife of the said Francis Shenton and of her Children in such manner as my Executor shall thinke fit or approve of And I doe give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my said Brother Shenton's and his small Estate what soever not herein before by mee disposed of my debts and funerals Charges (which I have severally charged & d. I will not exceed one hundred poundes being first deducted) unto my loving brother Mr Daniel Ellison Esq^r. And I doe hereby nominate constitute make ordaine and appoint my said brother Daniel Ellison the full and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament And I doe hereby revoke and make void all former Wills Codicils and Requests here tofore by mee made and given (except the Will by mee made bearing date with these presents as touching and concerning all my Messuaged Lands Tenements and hereditaments what soever which said Will I doe hereby further approve and confirm.) In witness whereof I the said Francis Shenton have hereunto set my hand and seal and published the same as my last Will and Testament of and touching my personall Estate this thowertenth day of December in the year of our Lord God 1674 And in the Six and Twentieth year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lord Charles the second by the grant of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c. Francis Ellison of Newstreete in the Parish of St Bridget alias Brided London Doctor in Physick being first in body but of sound mind and memory prayed be God having heard my last Will and Testament as well touching my real as my personall Estate dated the thowertenth day of December 1674 read unto mee and having considered of the same doe publish and declare this present writing a Codicill to be added to my said Will and to be part and parcel of the same whereof by my said Will touching my real Estate And by two severall Indentures of Lease and Release therein mentioned and recited I have conveyed letted and assured divers Messuaged Lands and Tenements in the Parish of St Giles in the fields and St Clement Danes in the County of Midd^x in the said Indentures or last Will mentioned in a certain and successfull order unto certain persons therein named as by the said Indentures and Will more fully may appear Now my Will is And I doe hereby direct and appoint that the said Messuaged Lands and premises in whole hands or possession since the same shall successfull come or vest by virtue of any Clause or Clause in the said Indentures and Will or any of them contained shall be charged as followeth that is to say that the person and persons from time to time holding and enjoying the same shall send shall send unto my brother Henry upon his lawfull demand the sume of fiftie poundes per quarter of current money of England and deliver the same quarterly into the hand of my said brother and not into the hand of any other person what soever in manner following that is to say upon the Twentieth day of December fiftie poundes upon the Twentieth day of March other fiftie poundes upon the Twentieth day of June other fiftie poundes and upon the Twentieth day of September yearly other fiftie poundes the first time or delivery of the same to be made upon such of the said quarterly dayes as shall first and next happen after my decease provided nevertheless and on this Condition all that my said brother Henry shall from time to time upon receipt of every one of the said payments or loanes shall and doo deliver a
